

Homework Grading Policy

Homework is the students chance to practice the skills and techniques we have learned in class. Therefore, grading on homework will focused more on effort and completeness and less on if the answer is correct. Students will be given 2 days on almost all homework assignments. Homework will be assigned every Monday and will be due on Wednesday. On Wednesday students will receive a new homework assignment that will be due on Friday. Students and parents can primarily bank on this schedule for the majority of the year. Occasionally there may be gaps or additions to this schedule, but they will be the exception to the rule. In an effort to promote responsibility and work ethic, no late homework will be accepted in class. However, late assignments can be turned in through the SCP (Schoolwork Completion Program) for the credit shown in the grading scale below. Students have been well versed in this policy to avoid any confusion about not knowing the policy.

Grading Scale for Homework

- 4 - All work is shown (including “new push” if appropriate), proper labels or units used, and work is neat/organized.**
- 3 - Most work is shown (“new push” not used when could have), missing labels or units, work is somewhat neat/organized.**
- 2 - *Highest score possible for late work from SCP. This score not used for on-time assignments.* All work is shown (including “new push” if appropriate), proper labels or units used, and work is neat/organized.**
- 1 - Incomplete or missing work. Only answers with no supporting work. Unorganized work and missing labels or units.**
- 0 - No homework turned in when graded in class.**
