

What is Schoolwork Completion Program (SCP)?

SCP is offered as a great opportunity for your student to complete missing homework while they receive extra help they may need. This program is highly recommended with the intent as a support program to give your student extra time in their school day to complete any required assignments.

How SCP Works

1. Teachers submit names to the counseling office on the Thursday before the student is assigned to attend. Parents will be notified by email/phone call on Friday. Your student will be handed a copy of this letter on Friday by the teacher that has assigned them to the program. By notifying students and parents/guardians on Friday allows you and your student 5 days to check on family access for missing assignments, and gives time for your student to ask teachers questions. To check student's grades click on the student's grade for the class you are viewing and look for missing assignments, check marks and zeros, please do not look under the missing assignment tab.
2. SCP will run on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday the following week. Your student should attend until all of the missing homework is handed in. When your student hands in their homework to their teacher they will receive a slip stating: At this point he/she has turned in all missing work to teacher and no longer needs to attend SCP for the remainder of this week. Copies of slip go to parents (white copy), yellow or "golden ticket" to Mr. Fannin or office and the pink to the classroom teacher. If a student finishes the homework on the weekend and turns their homework in on Monday, they will be excused from the program for the week. They will still need to get their "golden ticket" to Mr. Fannin. Remember that our goal is to help students keep up on their homework.
3. Students will report to the pack 400 shared area by 2:45 on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday with a printed progress report. The program ends at 4:00 pm and parents will need to pick up their student by the front doors. **We no longer provide transportation.** As a safety precaution, parents will be emailed/phoned if their student does not show up.

What Happens if My Student Does Not Attend?

SCP is no longer required, but we hope parents will still want to take advantage of this great opportunity. If your student does not attend SCP, an academic intervention will be added on their discipline. All discipline can be viewed on family access. There is not a consequence for not attending, but if your student does not attend for 5 times that they have been recommended we will no longer recommend them or include them in the program. If you decide later that you would like your student to start attending please contact Mr. Fannin at 972-5700 to reinstate them.
